additional information

Hell is also sometimes called **Gehenna**. This is another name for the **(Ben-)Hinnom valley**, a valley next to Jerusalem, southwest of the city. In this valley, in the time of the kings of Judah, children were sacrificed to the idol Moloch. (Today there is a park on that spot.)

2 Chronicles 28:3 and 33:6 King Josiah radically ended idolatry in this valley and the rest of the land. 2 Kings 23:1-20 Unfortunately, this was temporary.

Jeremiah 7:31

This valley is a model for the real hell: the place where God is not.

King Josiah is a model for King Jesus defeating the devil and his helpers once and for all.
